Motion: WVSEBM Nathan Fields made a motion to accept amendment to Article II, Section A and Section A paragraphs 1 and 2 of the "Welfare Benefits Trust Agreement" by deleting the current section and paragraphs and replacing with the following:

- A. **Trustees** There will be five (5) Trustees who shall each serve for a term of three years. The Union shall appoint all five (5) Trustees. The Union has a right to remove a Trustee for any reason, prior to the end of the Trustee's term.
 - 1. **Successors** A Trustee may be removed or resign at any time. The Union shall fill all vacancies. As long as there are at least three Trustees serving in this capacity, the Trust may operate notwithstanding all vacancies have not been filled.
 - 2. **Qualification of Trustees** At least two (2) Trustees must be members of the Union and one Trustee must be a person who is otherwise unaffiliated with the Union. A quorum shall consist of three (3) Trustees.

The Amendment is effective the 1st day of January 2018.

The motion was seconded by NCSEBM Cynthia Brown and moved forward unanimously.

The teleconference for the NPMHU Local 305 Council was called to order at 5:03 PM and the roll call was taken by Recording Secretary Burnside. (Roll-call attached)

The purpose of the teleconference was to discuss the RI-399 Global Settlement. On June 26, 2018, the National parties agreed to a tripartite Memorandum of Understanding to update the RI-399 Dispute Resolution Procedures.

The update resolves many of the pending disputes now being held at the National, Regional and Local levels. All National disputes pending as of September 1, 2017 are withdrawn, with the parties accepting the USPS determinations previously issued. There are two exceptions to the rule on pending National disputes; the Small Parcel Sorting System (SPSS) and the Advanced Facer Canceller System (AFCS). These jurisdictional disputes will be arbitrated at the National level.

The MOU update will provide a monetary payment to Mail Handlers and Clerks. Details about the distribution and amounts have yet to be determined.

President Jackson requests that all Branch Presidents forward to the Local Office a copy of all current Facility Inventories by June 29, 2018.

With no further business to discuss on this date, the teleconference was officially adjourned at 5:18 PM.
